

OFFICIAL CALL
Convention of the King George County
Republican Committee of Virginia

As Chairman of the King George County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, P. Scott Tucker, do hereby issue this call for a County Convention to be held at Hanover Baptist Church Fellowship Hall 10312 Hanover Church Rd., King George, VA 22485, on May 9th, 2013 at 7:00 pm, registration beginning at 5:45 pm and ending promptly at 6:45 pm local time for the following purposes:

1. Nominating one Republican candidate for Board of Supervisors Monroe Precinct and nominating one Republican candidate for Board of Supervisors Shiloh Precinct.
2. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation:

All legal and qualified voters of King George County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Delegates for this convention will have been elected at the May 28th Mass Meeting.

Composition of Convention:

The County Convention shall be composed of delegates and alternate delegates of the respective precincts they represent. Representation shall be based on a percentage of the total number of Republican votes cast in each precinct in the last gubernatorial and presidential elections combined. Monroe Precinct is entitled to up to sixty-one (61) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates and Shiloh Precinct is entitled to up to forty three (43) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the King George County Convention. Each precinct is entitled to one (1) Delegate vote per 50 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election. Weighted voting does not apply. If fewer than two candidates file for each respective precinct the applicant may be deemed the Nominee and the convention may cancelled at the discretion of the Committee.

Filing Requirements:

Candidates for the nomination for Board of Supervisors at the aforementioned County Convention shall file a written application by mail, by representative or at a duly called meeting, to the King George Republican Committee P.O. Box 221 King George, VA 22485, which must be received not later than 6:59pm Thursday April 25th, 2013. Please include the header "Board of Supervisor Filing Form" if e-mailing.

Registration Fee:

There will be a \$10.00 voluntary registration fee to participate in this convention. There is a \$200.00 mandatory registration fee to file for Republican Board of Supervisors Candidate.

Post-marks do not govern. Applications will also be accepted in person or by representative at all properly called meetings of the King George Republican Committee or by the Chairman prior to April 26th, 2013. Only those who properly pre-file for King George County Monroe Precinct or Shiloh Precinct Supervisor can be nominated at the Convention for those respective positions. No candidates may be nominated from the floor.

There is a \$10.00 voluntary fee to participate as a Delegate and/or attend this Convention.
