I'm happy to announce that earlier this afternoon, the full Senate voted on final passage to approve Senate Bill 610, my bill which will restore and expand Virginia's concealed carry reciprocity agreements. This not only reverses the decision of the Attorney General in late December to sever many of the existing agreements Virginia has with other states, but will also expand Virginia's reciprocity agreements with additional states. My bill now goes to the Governor's desk for his signature. I'm thrilled that the Governor has agreed to sign this bill--it will soon be law of the land.
