

**OFFICIAL CALL**  
**Mass Meeting of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee**  
**of the Republican Party of Virginia**  
**April 10, 2012 at the Williamsburg Regional Library Auditorium**  
**515 Scotland St., Williamsburg VA 23185**

As Chairman of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Harry Ambrose, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee to be held at Williamsburg Regional Library Auditorium 515 Scotland St., Williamsburg VA 23185, starting at 7:00 p.m. local time on April 10, 2012 for the following purposes:

1. Electing up to 16 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on June 16, 2012 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, beginning at 10:00 a.m. for the purposes of electing a State Party Chairman, RNC National Committeeman, RNC National Committeewoman, 13 At-Large Delegates and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and two At-Large Presidential Electors. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee is entitled to 16 Delegate Votes;
2. Electing up to 40 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to cast 40 votes at the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia, to be held on May 12, 2012 at the T.C Waller Elementary School, 6099 T.C. Walker Road, Gloucester, Virginia, beginning at 1:00 p.m. for the purposes of electing a District Chairman; three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention; a Presidential Elector; elect three members to the Republican Party of Virginia State Central Committee; and such other business as may properly come before the convention.. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 500 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that City of Williamsburg Republican Committee is entitled to 40 Delegate Votes; and
3. Electing a Chairman for the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee; and
4. Electing the members of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee; and
5. Conduct such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

**Qualifications for Participation**

1. All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.
2. In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent.
3. A single exception to Paragraph 3 shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the

nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in Paragraph 3 thereafter.

4. In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the date of election as a Delegate. A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements of this section, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

#### **Filing Requirements**

Pre-filing is not required.

#### **Registration Fee**

A voluntary fee of \$5 is requested of each participant of the Mass Meeting. Make checks payable to the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee and submit in person if attending the Mass Meeting of the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee, Virginia

A mandatory fee of \$10 is required for membership in the Committee. Make checks payable to the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee and submit at the Mass Meeting.

A voluntary fee of \$10 is requested of each Delegate and Alternate to the Biennial Convention of the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District of the Republican Party of Virginia. Make checks payable to the City of Williamsburg Republican Committee and submit at the Mass Meeting.

A voluntary fee of \$35 is requested of each Delegate and Alternate to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention. Make checks payable to City of Williamsburg Republican Committee and submit at the Mass Meeting.
